**Davenport, Iowa**

Volunteers will collect school supplies for an under-resourced school.

**East Palo Alto, California**

Seniors from the East Palo Alto Senior Center will come together to share incredible stories about voting experiences when they lived in the Deep South. The audience will be encouraged to ask questions and to join in with stories of their own. The senior band and chorus will provide live music.

**Gulfport, Mississippi**

Volunteers will make necessary repairs to the homes of low-income elderly and disabled members of the community.

**Corvallis, Oregon**

High school students will join together to build a much-needed bicycle shelter at the Jackson Street Youth Shelter.

**Talkeetna, Alaska**

Volunteers will gather at the public library to write letters to soldiers in Iraq and Afghanistan.

**Metuchen, New Jersey**

The Arc of Middlesex County Pageturner Bookstores will host a book drive for children's books to be donated to local day care centers and hospitals. People with developmental disabilities will be assisted in sorting and distributing the books.

**Santa Fe, New Mexico**

The Mary Esther Gonzales Senior Center will host a series of documentary films produced by the ACLU on various civil rights topics.

**State College, Pennsylvania**

An AmeriCorps team will hold an Energy Efficiency Fair to help community members improve energy efficiency in their homes. They will demonstrate weatherproofing techniques, hand out energy efficient light bulbs, and create draft guards to fit the bottoms of doorways. A sample window will provide visitors with the opportunity to practice weatherproofing.
